DOG BAY CATCH DIVISION UPDATES & CHANGES FROM 2011

- **Four person teams**
For 2012 four person teams are allowed for the Hog division.
- **The Heavy Hog Bonus category**
Bonus Category for the heaviest is allowing Sows to be included for the 2012 Challenge.
- **Wounded Warriors Project**
Teams may guide up to four wounded warriors that were injured while on active duty serving our countries armed forces. Teams may restrain hogs at the bay but a Wounded Warrior must harvest the animal with a knife. It is suggested that Wounded Warriors that have mobility restrictions not be put in harm's way during a bay scenario and should remain on a transportation vehicle during this time. Additional attendees may go along to video or take photos as well as assist any Wounded Warrior team. (Note: Wounded Warriors will have to pay the same entry fee as all teams and is only allowed assistance for their disability) All Wounded Warriors are eligible for all prize categories. Anyone wishing to hunt with an individual or team of Wounded Warriors please contact Ken Scurry at 404-732-5658.
- **Breaking A Tie**
In the event of a tie, the heaviest individual harvest will break any tie. In the event of a weigh off tie, the first team to check in will then be the winner.
- **Thermal / Night Vision Optics**
The use of thermal or night vision optics to spot and cast dogs are not allowed. This was not allowed in 2011.
- **Firearms / Archery**
Harvesting hogs by means of a firearm or bow will not be permitted in the Challenge for 2012. The Challenge is only open to Dog hunting and the only means of harvest will be with a knife. In 2011 we had a Still Hunt Division allowing hunting by means of a bow or firearm. We only had one team sign up. (This division has been omitted for 2012 due to lack of participation.)
- **Largest Stringer**
SOS considered having the largest stringer (The most hogs harvested) for the 2012 Challenge. This division was inadvertently not included on the website during early registration and many signed up without knowing of this division. We have since removed this and may consider this in future events.

PREDATOR HUNTING DIVISION UPDATES & CHANGES FROM 2011

- Wounded Warriors Project

Two man teams may take one Wounded Warrior along to hunt.

(No additional changes in the predator division for 2012.)

Scurry Outdoors South is promoting the **SECOND ANNUAL GREAT SOUTH PREDATOR & WILD HOG CHALLENGE** to draw hunters together to share their enthusiasm for predator and wild hog hunting. This is the first hunting event of its kind to be offered in the Southeast. All participants must abide by all local, state and federal game laws to make this event enjoyable, fair and most of all safe for all who participate. This year, Scurry Outdoors South is teaming up with Georgia Outdoor News – GON Networks Sportsman’s Pantry. We will be serving BBQ with fixings. Teams and spectators will be asked for a donation for each meal that will go to support the Sportsman’s Pantry.

Scurry Outdoors South is partnering with the Wounded Warriors Project to help get wounded veterans involved in the Challenge. Anyone interested in supporting this effort can contact us to assign a veteran to your team.

WILD HOG CHALLENGE DIVISION

Longest Cutter Division - Will be judged based on the longest combined bottom cutters (Bottom Tusk) in length, measured to the nearest eighth of an inch.

- **First Place**
 - **\$1,000.00 Payout to team**

In the event of a tie: The heaviest hog will be the winner.

PREDATOR CHALLENGE DIVISION

Predator Challenge Division: This is for two (2) person teams who will hunt for the following predators: Coyote, Bobcat and Fox. The team with the highest combined score will win first place. The scoring process will be broken down by the following point system:

- ❖ Bobcat.....20 Points
- ❖ Coyote:.....15 Points
- ❖ Fox:.....10 Points (Reds or Grey's)
- ❖ In the event of a tie, the first team that checks in will be the winner.

CHALLENGE SCHEDULE

- Teams may enter from any state in the US as long as they hunt in the Southeast.
- The entry fee is the same for any division \$150.00 for both divisions. Teams must fill in the Wild Hog or Predator entry forms to register. All forms must be completed.
- Hunting teams will begin hunting at locations of their choice on Friday January 27, 2012 at 12:00 AM. (SEE RULES!!!)
- The Challenge Will Officially End: Sunday January 29, 2012 at 1:00 PM at Bass Pro Shop in Macon, Georgia parking lot weigh in location.
- Be sure to give ample travel time to get to the check in location by 1:00 PM.
- Any individual or team not checked in by 1:00 PM on Sunday, January 29, 2012, will be disqualified. (NO EXCEPTIONS!!!)
- Prizes will be awarded immediately following the close of the hunt on Sunday, once all divisions have been collected and scored. All participants will have a photo opportunity with their harvest at the scales.

OFFICIAL HUNT RULES

“CHEATING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!”

Any team that does not follow the official hunt rules of the challenge will be immediately disqualified. All finalists will be subject to a polygraph test following the final check in of the challenge. You will be asked a series of questions. If your team captain should show deception of any kind you will immediately be disqualified. The team’s entry fee will not be refunded and you will be fined \$500.00 plus the cost of the polygraph test. It will not be worth the shame, embarrassment or the fine.

GENERAL RULES

- Only hunters with valid hunting licenses may participate. Minors may hunt only with an appropriately licensed parent or guardian. If a minor is hunting as a team mate, a parent or guardian must fill in all of the information for the minor.
- Hunters may hunt in any location of their choice providing they have permission by the land owner. All teams must meet compliance with all local, state and federal hunting regulations in the regions they wish to hunt. See link provided to various regional state sites providing this information.
- All teams must try to preserve their harvest as best as possible. Use large tubs, ice bags and tarps to help preserve your harvest prior to check in.
- Only fresh kills will be accepted. Decomposing or frozen carcasses will cause your team to be disqualified. (NO EXCEPTIONS!)
- **TEAM NUMBER:** Hunters must take a photo of each harvest using the supplied ***team number sign that is part of this registration packet***. Between 9:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. Thursday, January 26, Team Captain must call (404) 732-5658 to be assigned team number. Once team number is assigned, you must write it legibly in permanent ink your team number on number sign.

- Each animal must be tagged with bright survey flagging tape and permanent ink marker legibly marked on each animal along with their SOS assigned team number, including date and time of kill.
- Any hunters exhibiting influence of drugs or alcohol will cause their team to be immediately disqualified.
- No team may accept animals from another team or hunter. (NO EXCEPTIONS!)
- Any team submitting an animal with physical evidence of having been pen-raised, trapped, snared or road kills will be immediately disqualified. (NO EXCEPTIONS!)
- Following final check in, teams are responsible for disposing of all animals in an appropriate manner.
- Registration indicates participant agrees to a polygraph if randomly selected and that failure of such will result in immediate disqualification from the hunt AND personal liability for the cost of the polygraph tests as well a \$500.00 fine.

WILD HOG DIVISION

- ***Wild Hog Division is for Dog Bay Catch Only! Hogs must be harvested by knife only, no guns allowed.***
- All Wild Hogs must be of feral origin. Any Hog that does not meet the characteristics of a Wild Hog and shows any resemblance or appearance of a domesticated Hog will not be accepted and result in team disqualification.
- Wild Sows will be eligible for the competition in the Heaviest Wild Boar/Sow division.
- The hunt is only open to free range Wild Hogs and Wild Sows. Barr Hogs (castrated), high fence hogs or trophy plantation hogs are not allowed in the Challenge. (NO EXCEPTIONS!!!)
- Thermal and night vision optics **are prohibited** for spotting in the Wild Hog Division.

PREDATOR DIVISION:

- Predators allowed in this category are limited to Coyote, Bobcat and Fox (Reds or Grey's).
- All predators must be harvested in a humane manner.
- All hunters must abide by their local, state and federal game laws by which their harvest is taken (See link below).
- Thermal and night vision optics **are allowed** in the Predator Division.

The Ten Commandments of Gun Safety

- 1. Never rely on your gun's safety. Treat every gun as if it were loaded and ready to fire.**
- 2. Never cross a fence, climb a tree or jump a ditch with a loaded gun.**
- 3. Never load or carry a loaded gun until you are ready to use it.**
- 4. Watch your muzzle so your companions do not have to.**
- 5. Store guns and ammunition separately; and in locked storage.**
- 6. Do not shoot unless you are absolutely sure of your target and what is beyond it.**
- 7. Know the range of your gun. A .22 rimfire can travel over a mile.**
- 8. Always wear eye and ear protection when shooting any gun.**
- 9. Always be sure the barrel is clear of obstructions. Carry only the proper size ammunition for the gun you are using.**
- 10. Alcohol and Drugs do not mix with guns!**
